AN ACT ALLOWING ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION OF A CERTIFIED GOVERNMENTAL ACCOUNTANT AS DETERMINED BY THE MASSACHUSETTS MUNICIPAL AUDITORS' AND ACCOUNTANTS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 41, sections 48, 49A and 55 of the General Laws are hereby amended by adding at the
- 2 end of each section the following:—
- 3 Any appointee to this position who has been designated a “Certified Governmental Accountant”
- 4 by the Massachusetts Municipal Auditors’ and Accountants’ Association, Inc., shall, beginning
- 5 with the beginning of the fiscal year following acceptance of this provision by a town meeting in
- 6 towns and the city council and mayor in cities, receive additional compensation in an amount to
- 7 be determined in each city or town, but in no case less than one thousand dollars in each fiscal
- 8 year.
