### AN ACT PROVIDING COUNTY CORRECTIONS OFFICIALS WITH CERTAIN RETIREMENT BENEFITS AFTER TWENTY YEARS OF SERVICE .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 28N of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the  
2 words "correction or jail officer", the following words:— or any employee classified under Group 4.
