AN ACT REQUIRING FAIR REPORTING OF HOURS WORKED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the
2 contrary, any requested or supplied information with regard to any public employee's yearly
3 salary shall contain the total hours worked for said employee.
