**AN ACT RELATIVE TO EDUCATIONAL CREDITS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any General or special law to the contrary the Board of Higher Education is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to grant life experience credits for any police officer enrolled in academic courses under the  
3 Quinn Bill who was serving on active duty with the United States Military at the time of their enrollment in the  
4 program as would have been granted prior to July 1, 2004.
