# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

AN ACT TO AMEND THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH SERVICES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Group 4 paragraph (g) of sub-division 2 of section 3 of Chapter 32, as  
2 amended by section (1) of Chapter 71 of the acts of 1996, is hereby further amended, by  
3 inserting after the words "supervising prison camp officer," the following words:—"Youth  
4 Services Program Officer I, II."
