AN ACT TO INCLUDE CERTAIN EMPLOYEES IN TOWNS AND CITIES IN GROUP 2 FOR
RETIREMENT PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (g) of subsection (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 247, after the
3 word “powers” the following words:— employees of the board of health or department of public
4 health and any director, inspector, sanitarian or public health nurse and any other health agent or
5 officer who performs similar duties of the enforcement of public laws.
