AN ACT RELATIVE TO A RETIRED STATE POLICE OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 32 of the General 2 Laws or any other general or
2 special law to the contrary, Lawrence 3 W. Finneran of Hanover, formerly a state police officer, who has
3 4 been retired under the provisions of Chapter 32 or similar provisions 5 of earlier law, on account of
4 injuries sustained or of the hazards 6 undergone in the performance of his duty, shall have his retirement 7
5 allowance increased to an amount not exceeding one half the rate of 8 regular compensation payable to
6 state police officers holding similar 9 positions at the time of increasing such allowance, in the
7 comparable 10 grade or classification, as determined by the personnel administrator, 11 occupied by such
8 former officer at the time of his retirement.
