**In the Year Two Thousand and Nine.**  
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AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RENEWABLE ENERGY INCOME TAX CREDIT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 6 (d) of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "fifteen per cent", in line 21, and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following:— 50 per cent.

4           SECTION 2. Said Section 6 (d) of said chapter 62, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by  
5 striking out the words "one thousand dollars", in line 22, and inserting in place thereof the  
6 figure:— \$5,000 or five thousand dollars.

7           SECTION 3. Said Section 6 (d) of said chapter 62, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by  
8 inserting after line 52 the following clause:—  
9 (iii) an energy bill summary for the previous 12 months from the utility or energy company, or  
10 actual bills, before the installation of the system and a 12 month summary of bills after the  
11 installation of the system, or bills, from the utility or energy company must be submitted as proof  
12 of a reduction in energy usage directly attributable to the new system with the tax credit form to  
13 qualify for the credit.

14           SECTION 4. Said Section 6 (d) (II) of said chapter 62, as so appearing, is hereby further  
15 amended by inserting after "... United States Department of Housing and Urban Development,"  
16 the words:-- or any subsidy or loan interest or principle amount provided by the Commonwealth.
