AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE MASSACHUSETTS MEDAL OF LIBERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 33 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 67 the following section:-
- 2 Section 67A. There shall be a Massachusetts medal of liberty which shall be awarded to the next of kin
- 3 of service men and women who were killed in action as a result of enemy terrorism. The adjutant general
- 4 and 2 field grade officers of the armed forces of the commonwealth detailed by the commander-in-chief
- 5 shall constitute a commission to make recommendations to the commander-in-chief for the awarding of
- 6 the medal of liberty.
