AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF ELECTRICAL EXAMINERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 13: Section 32. Board; membership; appointment; term; executive secretary;  
2 compensation and expenses In line three after the word "and " striking the word eight and adding the  
3 word; twelve. In line twelve after the word "electrician;" striking the word one and adding the word; five.  
4 In line 16 after the word "Purposes" adding the words; and whom at the time of appointment shall be a  
5 member or an employee of a member of a trade union or a party or an employee of a party to a contract  
6 with a trade union;
