## AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PUBLIC RECORDS LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 7(26)(q) of chapter 4 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

2           SECTION 2. Section 31 of chapter 46 is hereby amended by inserting the following language at the end  
3 of the section:-

4           “Adoption contact information and indices created from the adoption contact registry established  
5 by this section shall not be public record subject to disclosure pursuant to chapter 66.”
