AN ACT RELATIVE TO ENERGY PLANNING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The M.G.L. are amended by the following language. Not with standing any
2 general law to the contrary the Secretary of Energy and the Environment shall develop a plan
3 that anticipates the cost of fossil fuels increasing exponentially over the next ten years. The
4 secretary shall create a pragmatic plan that will retrofit existing residential buildings in the
5 Commonwealth to meet energy efficiency requirements that will lower overall energy usage per
6 unit by at least fifty percent over a ten year period. Said plan shall be completed within one year
7 of the passage of this bill.
