The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION
OF THE FEASIBILITY OF HOSTING THE OLYMPICS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 **RESOLVED** that a special commission, to consist of 3 members of the senate, 1 to be appointed by the
2 minority leader, 3 members of the house of representatives, 1 to be appointed by the minority leader and 3 members
3 to be appointed by the governor is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative
4 to the feasibility of bidding for a future summer Olympics. Said investigation and study shall include but not be
5 limited to the prospects of working with other New England states and should seek input from local governments
6 especially in our larger cities and other organizations and agencies.
- 7 Said commission shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study, and its
8 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by
9 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of December, 2007.
