In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

AN ACT RELATIVE TO NAMING "THE ROAD TO BOSTON" IN MEMORY OF BENNY EMERICK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any rule or regulation of the department of highways to the  
2 contrary, a portion of Route 16 in Uxbridge shall be designated and known as Benny Emerick's  
3 "Road to Boston" The department of highways shall erect suitable markers bearing this  
4 designation in compliance with the standards of the department and any existing historic  
5 preservation guidelines or statutes.
