**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RIDE SERVICE OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY
TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 161A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
2 Section 49. The authority shall make the services of The Ride available to persons residing in any community
3 within 25 miles of the city of Boston to transport them to the city of Boston for medical related purposes.
4 The authority shall be reimbursed for the costs of providing such services by the commonwealth health insurance
5 connector board established by section 2 of chapter 176Q.
