AN ACT REQUIRING THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE ALTERNATIVE FUEL AT THEIR FACILITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, the Massachusetts Turnpike
2 Authority is hereby authorized and directed to develop, by December 31, 2010, compressed natural gas dispensing
3 and electric vehicle recharging facilities at the Framingham, Natick and Ludlow Turnpike rest areas; furthermore,
4 the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority is hereby authorized and directed to develop, by December 31, 2010,
5 compressed natural gas dispensing and electric vehicle recharging at all Massachusetts Turnpike rest areas.
