Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 37E of chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 62A of chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
