## AN ACT RELATIVE TO STREET LIGHTING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 34A of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Town" in line 1 the following:- or any other public or  
3 quasi public agency or entity.

4 SECTION 2. Said section 34A of such chapter 164, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by  
5 inserting after the word "municipality" in lines 12, 13, 29, 31, 35, 37, 44, 48, 52, 57 both times it appears  
6 60, 65, and 70 the following:- or any other public or quasi public agency or entity.
