DECISION

This was a hearing concerning alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch.138 §34 - Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age.

The licensee stipulated to the facts of the investigator's report, which stated that an underage operative, working under the supervision of A.B.C.C. investigators, purchased a Miller Light. The minor, whose date of birth is 9/4/86 age 20, was not asked for ID. A copy of the sting guidelines, and a photo and release of the minor were submitted.

Peter White, the licensee, stated that he fired the clerk who sold the beer to the minor. He was out of town when the violation occurred. The establishment has been in business since 1955 and has not had any violations with the Commission.

Based on the evidence, the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission finds that the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch.138 §34 - Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age and, therefore, issues a warning.
