DECISION

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether Iron Maiden, Inc. violated 204 CMR 2.05(2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count).

The licensee stipulated to the facts contained in the Investigator's compliance check field report dated May 28, 2008.

The report states an underage operative, d.o.b. 11/29/90 (age 17) purchased a Coors Light Beer for \$3.25 at the Trowbridge Tavern & Ale House. The young woman was not asked for identification by the bartender.

The Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05(2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count) and, therefore, **suspends the license for 4 days of which 4 days will be held in abeyance** for a period of two years provided no further violations of Ch. 138 or Commission regulations occur.
