DECISION

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether Sunrich, Inc. (licensee) was in violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count).

The licensee stipulated to the facts of the Investigator's report. Investigator Carey testified that the licensee served an underage operative an alcoholic beverage without checking their identification. The licensee, who has been in business for 4 years, stated that his wife was not paying attention but all employees will ask for identification in the future.

The Commission finds the licensee in violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count) and, therefore, **suspends the license for 2 days.**
