NOTICE OF ACTION

RE: Alzheimers Association, City Hall Plaza

1. A request for a variance was filed with the Board by Marie Kelly (Applicant) on June 15, 2018
The applicant has requested variances from the following sections of the 06 Rules and Regulations of the Board:

20.1	Petitioner seeks relief to install a trailer on city hall plaza which will contain an escape game like activity, the trailer will not be accessibly.

2. The application was heard by the Board as an incoming case on Monday, June 18, 2018

3. After reviewing all materials submitted to the Board, the Board voted as follows:

WAIVE the two (2) week waiting period on incoming cases for this matter, and

GRANT relief to 20.1 & 25.1 on the condition that:

- An equivalent experience, subject to the approval of the Mayor's Commission for Persons with Disabilities, is provided, and
- For any future exhibition on City Hall Plaza conducted by the petitioner, they shall provide the Board with either proof of compliance or completed variance applications not less than six (6) weeks prior to the date of its opening.

PLEASE NOTE: All documentation (written and visual) verifying that the conditions of the variance have been met must be submitted to the AAB Office as soon as the required work is completed.

Any person aggrieved by the above decision may request an adjudicatory hearing before the Board within 30 days of receipt of this decision by filing the attached request for an adjudicatory hearing. If after 30 days, a request for an adjudicatory hearing is not received, the above decision becomes a final decision and the appeal process is through Superior Court.
