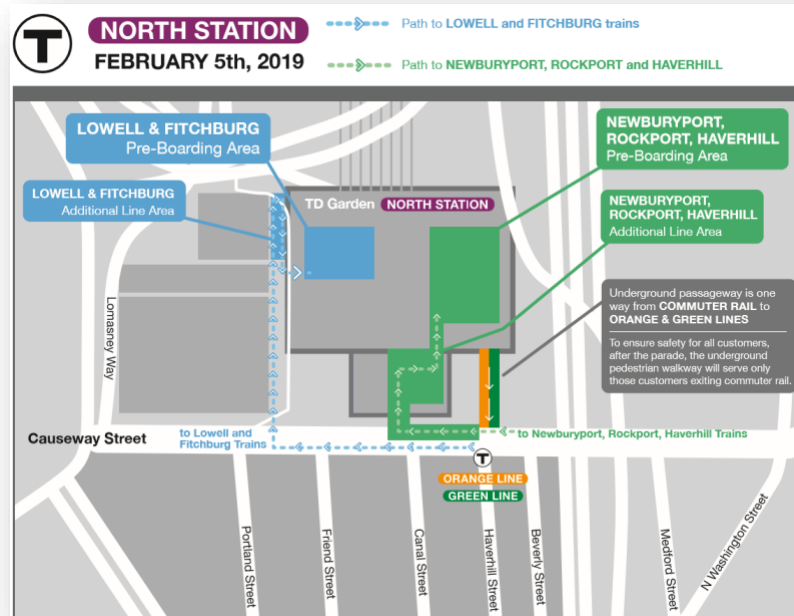
Patriots' Victory Parade Recap

- Subway: rush-hour service all day
- Commuter Rail: 30 additional trains beyond 507 regularly scheduled
- Ferry: Boston Harbor Cruises provided four additional vessels between Rowes Wharf and South Shore
- Buses: served critical role in keeping people moving
- Thanks to MBTA Operations staff, Transit Police, and Keolis for collective efforts to keep people moving
- Thanks also to ~80 T corporate volunteers who assisted with directions, scheduling, crowd control
- More than 9,000 pre-loaded CharlieCards sold

Patriots' Victory Parade: North Station Queuing System

- Improved queuing system at South, North, Back Bay stations
- Committed to continuous improvement
- Queueing facilitates safe, orderly departures from terminal stations



Friday, February 8, 2019 – Power Incident

- Late afternoon power failure occurred at Lincoln switching station
- Affected Blue, Green and Orange Line signals in the Downtown core area
- Faulted cable located on Causeway Street
- Emergency repairs required to fix faulted cable
- Project for full duct bank rebuild including building new redundant duct bank with cables in process
- Power Modernization Study initiated with final report expected Summer
