**Lt. Governor Karyn Polito's Schedule for Tuesday, May 14, 2019**

**BOSTON** – Tomorrow, Lt. Governor Karyn Polito will join Secretary of Public Safety and Security Thomas Turco, Deputy Secretary of Public Safety and Security Secretary Jennifer Queally, Department of Correction Commissioner Carol Mici, Suffolk County Sheriff Steven Tompkins, Norfolk County Sheriff Jerry McDermott, Hampden County Sheriff Nick Cocchi and elected officials to participate in the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Correctional Employee of the Year Awards.

Later, she will join Governor Charlie Baker and Secretary of Housing and Economic Development Michael Kennealy to testify before the Joint Committee on Housing regarding *An Act to Promote Housing Choices*, legislation filed by Governor Baker in February that calls for targeted zoning reform to advance new housing production in Massachusetts and supports the administration's goal to produce 135,000 new housing units by 2025.
