ANNUAL MEETING

The annual Meeting of the Board was held at the State House, Boston, Mass., on July 6, 1949. Final reports of Committees were received and the following officers were elected for the ensuing year: Herbert L. McCarthy, Chairman and A. Herve Query, Secretary

ADMINISTRATION

The Board held eleven meetings and the Annual Meeting. The meetings schedules for July 12, November 14, and March 14, 1950 were called to order by the Secretary but there being no quorum present, the meeting adjourned on each occasion.

COMITEE ON REGISTRATION

The Board held two examinations one on November 29, 30, Dec. 1, 1949 and one on December 13, 14, 15, 1949. At the November 29 examination there were forty-four candidates, thirty-five passed and nine failed. At the December 13th examination there were ten candidates, two passed and eight failed.

At the present time there are six hundred and thirty-two registered

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Chiropradists, nine have died within the past year and six have retired.

PROCTORING COMMITTEE

Three cases were acted upon by the Board as a result of complaints received. In two cases licenses were suspended, the third case was dropped by the complaintant.
