Charles H. Thorner was appointed by His Excellency Christian A. Herter on October 4, 1956 for a second term.

ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting was held on October 3, 1956. Final reports of Committees were received and the following officers were elected for the ensuing year: Chairman, Dr. A. Herve Query, Secretary, Dr. James F. Dunne. The Chairman appointed the following Committee Chairmen: Proctoring--Fred T. Reiss, Public Relations--Humphrey L. McCarthy, Registration--James F. Dunne, Education--Charles H. Thorner.

ADMINISTRATION

The Board held nine meetings and the Annual Meeting.

COMMITTEE ON REGISTRATION

The Board held one examination on June 18, 19, 20, 1957. The Board advertised a November examination in 1956, but there were no applicants. In June, fifteen applied for and eleven passed the examination. There were six hundred and sixty Chiropodists registered to practice in Massachusetts during this period. During the year ten retired and five were deceased. There were two who entered the Service.

EDUCATION

Three Chiropodists took the Hypo Certificate examination and qualified and were issued certificates.

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PROCTORING COMMITTEE

The Board received one complaint of a Physical Therapist practicing Chiropody. The man was called before the Board and agreed to desist. One complaint of a registered R. I. chiropodist practicing chiropody in this Commonwealth without a MASSACHUSETTS license. After investigation by the Board investigator the Board turned the case over to the Chiropody Board of R. I. and the chiropodist has stopped practicing in this Commonwealth. There were two cases of shoe men advertising "Foot Treatment" in local papers. One man was called before the Board and agreed to desist. The other case was turned over to the local Chiropody Association for action at a local level. There were eleven cases of failure to register with the City or Town clerk's office, twenty cases of improper signs, nineteen cases of improper listings in the Telephone Directory, and four cases of excessive advertising in newspapers. All cases were investigated by the Board investigator and all were cleared up amicably.
