ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting was held on October 17, 1962, final reports of Committees were received and the following officers were elected for the ensuing year: Chairman, Dr. Charles H. Thorner; Secretary, Dr. Robert Tabachnick. The Chairman appointed the following Committee Chairmen: Education, Dr. Gabriel H. Kitchener; Public Relations, Dr. Humphrey L. McCarthy; Registration, Dr. Robert Tabachnick; Proctoring, Dr. Robert Quinn, the latter was replaced by Dr. Joseph B. Addante when his term expired.

ADMINISTRATION

The Board held seven meetings and the Annual Meeting.

COMMITTEE ON REGISTRATION

The Board held one examination on June 18, 19, 20, 1963, one candidate was examined and passed the examination. There were six hundred and twenty-five Chiropodists registered to practice in Massachusetts during this period. Four Chiropodists



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retired, one entered the Service and four failed to register for 1963 and four were deceased.

EDUCATION COMMITTEE

NO REPORT

PROCTORING COMMITTEE

One case against the Paula Beauty Shop 410 Main St., Chatham of shaving corns and callouses. Investigator called on the Paula Beauty Shop and found the complaint was unfounded. One case of a chiropodist advertising as a chiropodist practicing in a shoe store. The chiropodist was called before the Board and agreed to desist. Two cases of illegal letter heads, both agreed to change their letter heads to conform to the Board's requested form. Ten cases of chiropodists not registering with their City or Town Clerk's Office. After being informed by the Investigator all complied with the law. One complaint against a chiropodist using obscene language to a patient, this case is being investigated further. Nine cases of improper telephone listings. All agreed to discontinue such listings.

PUBLIC RELATIONS

At several meetings throughout the year the liaison officer for the Massachusetts Podiatry Association appeared before the Board to inform the Board of the Association's legislative program.
