ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting was held on October 14, 1964, final reports of Committees were received and the following officers were elected for the ensuing year: Chairman, Dr. Gabriel Kitchener, Secretary Dr. Joseph B. Addante. When Dr. Kitchener's term expired, Dr. Thorner was elected Chairman. The following were appointed as Committee Chairman: Registration, Dr. Joseph B. Addante; Proctoring, Dr. Charles Thorner; Public Relations, Dr. Robert Tabachnick; Education, Dr. Humphrey L. McCarthy.

ADMINISTRATION

The Board held eight meetings and the Annual Meeting.

COMMITTEE ON REGISTRATION

The Board held two examinations, one on November 17, 18, 19, 1964, one candidate was examined and passed the examination. The second examination was held on June 22, 23, 24, 1965, three candidates were examined and three passed the examination. There were six hundred and five Chiropodists registered to practice in Massachusetts by renewing their certificates in 1965, three retired and nine were deceased.

PROCTORING COMMITTEE

There were six cases of improper advertising in the newspapers, after the investigator called and spoke to the chiroprodists, they agreed to desist. Six cases of improper stationery, all agreed to desist. Twelve cases of improper signs, after the investigator called and spoke to the individuals they all said they would correct their signs to the directive of the Board. Two cases of Shoe Stores with illegal signs. Both agreed to take down their signs after talking to the Board investigator. there were twelve cases of improper listing in the telephone directory, all made proper corrections after talking to the investigator.
