Lt. Governor Karyn Polito's Schedule for Thursday, June 6, 2019

BOSTON – Tomorrow, Lt. Governor Karyn Polito will visit Danvers High School to tour engineering and bio science classrooms using Project Lead the Way curriculum and announce a \$150,000 Skills Capital Grant to equip its new Innovation Pathways program in Information Technology and Manufacturing.

Then, she will join Manchester-by-the-Sea Town Administrator Greg Federspiel, Senator Bruce Tarr, Representative Brad Hill and local officials to participate in a ribbon cutting ceremony for the Morss Pier and Seawall Repair Project which received \$327,000 from the Seaport Economic Council in 2017.

Then, she will participate in a roundtable discussion on RESPECTfully, a statewide public awareness and prevention campaign to promote healthy relationships to young people, with staff members at the Beverly YMCA.
