

Chap. 16 RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSING THE CITY OF NORTHAMPTON FOR THE SUPPORT OF SMITH'S AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL AND NORTHAMPTON SCHOOL OF INDUSTRIES.

City of Northampton reimbursed for certain expenses.

Resolved, That the sum of eight thousand eight hundred forty-seven dollars and eighty-five cents be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, to the city of Northampton for the maintenance and support of Smith's Agricultural School and Northampton School of Industries.

Chap. 17 RESOLVE CONFIRMING THE ACTS OF GEORGE H. O'CONNELL OF NEWBURYPORT AS A JUSTICE OF THE PEACE.
