RE: Student Center, Milton Academy, 170 Center Street, Milton (V19-224)

On August 9, 2019, the Architectural Access Board received an Application for Variance containing 3 requests for relief. The Board reviewed this application at its August 26 & September 9, 2019 meetings, and after reviewing all documents that were provided the Board voted as follows:

Request 1: Wigglesworth & Warren Hall Entrances

CONTINUE the variance to 25.1 at the Wigglesworth Hall entrance to request the Petitioner provide a cost estimate for the installation of a ramp for this entrance only;

GRANT relief to 25.1 at the Warren Hall entrance as proposed;

Request 2: Wigglesworth Hall Egress Stair

GRANT relief to 26.6, 27.4.1, 27.4.2, 27.4.3, & 27.4.5 as proposed;

Request 3: Wigglesworth Hall Spiral Staircase

GRANT relief to 27.2 as proposed on the condition that the stairs otherwise fully comply with 521 CMR 27.

Any person aggrieved by the above decision may request an adjudicatory hearing before the Board within 30 days of receipt of this decision by filing the attached request for adjudicatory hearing form. If after 30 days, a request for adjudicatory hearing is not received, the above decision becomes a final order and the appeal process is through Superior Court.
