Monahan; thence north eighty-nine degrees and twenty-one minutes east, five hundred eighty-five feet to bound number twenty-five; thence south forty-eight degrees and two minutes east, two hundred eighty-nine and one tenth feet to bound number twenty-six on land of Raymond Schmidt; thence south fifty-six degrees and four minutes east, six hundred seventy-eight and six tenths feet to bound number twenty-seven; thence north sixty degrees and thirty minutes east, four hundred and fifty feet to the north line of the Greenfield Electric Light and Power Company; thence north seventy-nine degrees and fifty minutes east to the centre of the Deerfield river, on said north line of the Greenfield Electric Light and Power Company.

Shelburne Falls Fire District, limits changed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE PAYMENT OF A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY BY THE CITY OF FITCHBURG TO THE TOWN OF ASHBY.

*Chap. 362*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The city of Fitchburg is hereby authorized to pay to the town of Ashby the sum of six thousand dollars in full compensation for the loss sustained by the town as a result of the taking of certain taxable property other than land therein under the provisions of chapter six hundred and ninety-seven of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and fourteen.

City of Fitchburg may pay certain sum of money to town of Ashby.

SECTION 2. This act shall not affect the amount which may be paid by the city of Fitchburg to the town of Ashby in lieu of taxes upon the land, under the provisions of section ten of chapter twelve of the Revised Laws and of acts in amendment thereof.

Act not to affect operation of existing law.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISPOSITION OF SEWAGE FROM THE WORCESTER STATE HOSPITAL.

*Chap. 363*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Upon the acceptance by the city of Worcester of the provisions of this act, as hereinafter provided, the trustees of the Worcester state hospital shall construct a system of sewerage connecting said hospital with the system

of sewerage for said city, and may carry such sewers, drains, pipes and conduits as may be necessary for the purposes of this act under and along any street, railroad, railway, highway or other way, in such manner as not unnecessarily to obstruct the same, and may do any other thing necessary and proper for said purposes. The system of sewerage hereby authorized and required shall be completed by said trustees not later than the first day of November in the year nineteen hundred and sixteen, and said trustees may expend for the construction thereof a sum not exceeding four thousand dollars: *provided, however*, that no such connection between the said hospital and the Worcester system of sewerage shall be made unless the state department of health, after making a thorough investigation of the sewerage conditions of the Blackstone river and the conditions surrounding the present method of disposal of the sewage of the said hospital, shall certify to the auditor of the commonwealth that it is desirable from the point of view of the public health that the Worcester state hospital shall be connected with the sewerage system of the city of Worcester.

Proviso.

Rental.

SECTION 2. Upon the completion of said system of sewerage, said trustees shall annually pay to the city of Worcester as rental for the use of its sewerage system, as aforesaid, such sum as shall be fixed by agreement between the trustees of the Worcester state hospital and the superintendent of sewers of the city of Worcester.

Act to be submitted to city council, etc.

SECTION 3. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance by the mayor and city council of the city of Worcester, on or before the first day of July in the year nineteen hundred and sixteen.

*Chap. 364* AN ACT TO EXTEND THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE ACT TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Chief of police of Beverly placed under civil service.

SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter nineteen of the Revised Laws, and all acts in amendment thereof and in addition thereto, and the civil service rules and regulations made thereunder, and all acts now or hereafter in force relating to the appointment and removal of police officers, shall apply to the chief of police of the city of Beverly.
