Chap.369 AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE EXTENSION OF FURNACE BROOK PARKWAY FROM QUINCY SHORE RESERVATION TO HANCOCK STREET IN THE CITY OF QUINCY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Metropolitan park commission may complete extension of Furnace Brook parkway.

SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission is hereby authorized to expend a sum not exceeding eight thousand five hundred dollars for completing the construction of Furnace Brook parkway from Quincy Shore reservation to Hancock street, in the city of Quincy, one half of which amount shall be paid out of the ordinary revenue, and the other half shall be assessed upon the metropolitan district.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap.370 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF MEDFORD TO INCUR ADDITIONAL INDEBTEDNESS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

City of Medford may borrow money for construction of junior high school.

SECTION 1. The city of Medford is hereby authorized to borrow the sum of one hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars, in addition to the amount already authorized by law, for the purpose of constructing a junior high school, and the same shall not be reckoned in determining the statutory limit of indebtedness of the city. Said city may issue therefor its bonds or notes in the manner and form provided for in chapter seven hundred and nineteen of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and thirteen and shall in all other respects comply with the terms and conditions specified therein.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
