

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT TO THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR
ITS SUPPORT OF STATE PAUPERS. *Chap. 62*

Resolved, That a sum not exceeding fourteen thousand two hundred and seventy-six dollars and twenty-four cents be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth to the city of Boston, for the payment of certain bills for support of state paupers at the Boston city hospital which have been audited and allowed by the board of health, lunacy and charity, and are now on file in the office of the state auditor, in sums as follows, to wit: : — The sum of sixty-five hundred and three dollars and fifty-six cents for a period dating from December twenty-second, eighteen hundred eighty-two, to December thirty-first, eighteen hundred eighty-three, and a further sum of seven thousand seven hundred and seventy-two dollars and sixty-eight cents for certain other bills incurred in like manner for the year ending December thirty-first, eighteen hundred eighty-four. *Approved June 11, 1885.*

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR FIRE ESCAPES AND IMPROVEMENTS IN
THE HEATING APPARATUS AT THE STATE PRIMARY SCHOOL AT
MONSON. *Chap. 63*

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars, to be expended under the direction of the trustees of the state primary and reform schools, at the state primary school at Monson, to wit: — One thousand dollars for constructing fire escapes, and fifteen hundred dollars for a new steam boiler and repairs on steam heating apparatus. *Approved June 11, 1885.*

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF MACHINERY AND TOOLS
FOR THE MASSACHUSETTS REFORMATORY. *Chap. 64*

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding twelve thousand dollars, to be expended under the direction of the commissioners of prisons, for the purchase of machinery and tools for the Massachusetts reformatory.
