*Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars, to be expended under the direction of the surgeon general in the purchase of a new field outfit for the use of the medical department of the volunteer militia. *Approved April 12, 1893.*

RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF WILLIAM O'SULLIVAN.

*Chap. 59*

*Resolved*, That William O'Sullivan of Lawrence, father of William O'Sullivan, junior who served as captain of company K, fortieth regiment, New York volunteers, in the war of the rebellion, and was killed at the battle of Fredericksburg on the thirteenth day of December in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-two, shall, from and after the first day of February of the present year, be eligible to receive state or military aid under the provisions, rules and limitations of chapters two hundred and seventy-nine and three hundred and one of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, in the same manner and to the same extent that he would have been entitled had he served personally in said war to the credit of this Commonwealth. *Approved April 15, 1893.*

RESOLVE TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS AT THE STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AT FRAMINGHAM. *Chap. 60*

*Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding two thousand one hundred and six dollars, to be expended under the direction of the state board of education for the purpose of providing automatic heating and ventilating apparatus at the state normal school at Framingham. *Approved April 15, 1893.*
