For the above purpose the board may expend a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars, to be paid from the treasury of the commonwealth; but no work shall be done hereunder until the owners of the flats which would be affected thereby have released to the commonwealth all claims for damages which might arise from the said dredging.

RESOLVE TO PROVIDE FOR ENLARGING THE CHANNEL AT WOLLASTON BEACH IN THE CITY OF QUINCY.

*Chap.108*

*Resolved,* That the board of harbor and land commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to deepen and enlarge the channel dredged at Wollaston beach under the provisions of chapter three hundred and sixty-six of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and three, so that it shall be not less than sixty feet wide on the bottom and six feet deep at mean low water. For this purpose the board may expend a sum not exceeding seven thousand five hundred dollars.

RESOLVE TO PROVIDE FOR THE DREDGING OF AN ANCHORAGE BASIN IN HINGHAM HARBOR.

*Chap.109*

*Resolved,* That the board of harbor and land commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to dredge an anchorage basin at the head of Hingham harbor, to the depth of six feet at mean low water, and the board may expend for this purpose a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars.

RESOLVE TO PROVIDE FOR THE DREDGING OF AN ANCHORAGE BASIN IN LYNN HARBOR.

*Chap.110*

*Resolved,* That the board of harbor and land commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to dredge an anchorage basin in Lynn harbor, east of the main channel, to a depth of not less than six feet at mean low water, and outside the proposed location for the Market street extension boulevard. For the above purpose the said commissioners may expend from the treasury of the commonwealth a sum not exceeding ten thousand dollars.
