

For repairing, furnishing and improving county buildings, a sum not exceeding twelve thousand dollars. County tax,
Worcester.

For Quinsigamond bridge, a sum not exceeding twenty thousand dollars.

For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings, other than jails and houses of correction, and for care of the same, a sum not exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars.

For highways, including state highways, bridges and land damages, a sum not exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars.

For law libraries, a sum not exceeding six thousand dollars.

For the training school, a sum not exceeding twenty-three thousand dollars.

For pensions, a sum not exceeding nine thousand dollars.

For Wachusett Mountain state reservation, a sum not exceeding eight thousand five hundred dollars.

For county aid to agriculture, a sum not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars.

For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the current year, a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars.

And the county commissioners of said county are hereby authorized to levy as the county tax of said county for the current year, in the manner provided by law, the sum of five hundred sixty-five thousand dollars, to be expended, together with the cash balance on hand and the receipts from other sources, for the above purposes.
