## AN ACT

*To incorporate the Adelpic Union Society in Williams College.*

1 SEC. 1. **BE** *it enacted by the Senate and*  
2 *House of Representatives in General Court as-*  
3 *sembled, and by the authority of the same, That*  
4 *Amos D. Wheeler, David D. Gregory, Joseph*  
5 *Anderson, George N. Skinner, Orsamus Tin-*  
6 *ker, Barnabas Phinney and Mason Noble, to-*  
7 *gether with all others who may associate with*  
8 *them and their successors be and hereby are*  
9 *erected into and made a body politic and cor-*  
10 *porate by the name of the, "Adelpic Union*  
11 *Society of Williams College," and as such are*  
12 *hereby made capable of holding in their corpo-*  
13 *rate capacity, either by gift or purchase Books*

14 and other personal estate to an amount in value  
15 not exceeding Twelve Thousand Dollars.

1 SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That the said  
2 corporation shall have full power to make have  
3 and use a common seal and the same to break  
4 alter and renew at pleasure, and shall be capa-  
5 ble in law to sue and be sued, plead and be im-  
6 pleaded in any action or Court of Justice.

1 SEC. 3. *Be it further enacted*, That the said  
2 Corporation may make and establish all such  
3 by-laws and regulations not repugnant to the  
4 Constitution and laws of this Commonwealth  
5 as may be necessary for the government there-  
6 of.

1 SEC. 4. *Be it further enacted*, That all the  
2 Books and property now belonging to the Adel-  
3 phic Union Society in Williams College shall  
4 be and hereby is transferred to the said Cor-  
5 poration as soon as the same shall be organized  
6 by virtue of this Act. And the same together  
7 with all property that may hereafter be acquir-  
8 ed by said Corporation shall forever be and re-  
9 main so connected with Williams College that  
10 all members of said College who may become  
11 members of said Society may use and enjoy the  
12 same under the provisions of the by-laws of  
13 said Society.

1 SEC. 5. *Be it further enacted*, That Amos D.  
2 Wheeler above named is hereby authorized to  
3 call the first meeting of said Society by giving  
4 personal notice to the members of the Adelpic

5 Union Society now in Williams College at least  
6 seven days previous to the time of meeting.  
7 At which time said Society may proceed to or-  
8 ganize the same by choosing the necessary offi-  
9 cers thereof and fix the times and places for the  
10 future meetings of the same.
