

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIES RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF MINORS BETWEEN THE AGES OF SIXTEEN AND EIGHTEEN. *Chap. 28*

*Resolved,* That the department of labor and industries shall investigate the question of what trades, processes of manufacture and occupations, and particular methods of carrying on the same, from which minors under the age of sixteen are now excluded by law, are so dangerous or so injurious to the health of minors between the ages of sixteen and eighteen that such minors ought also to be excluded therefrom. Said department may expend for the purposes of this resolve such sum, not exceeding one thousand dollars, as may hereafter be appropriated therefor, and said department shall report to the general court its findings and recommendations, with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives not later than the first Wednesday of December in the current year.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DIVISION OF METROPOLITAN PLANNING RELATIVE TO THE EXTENSION OF RAPID TRANSIT FACILITIES IN THE EAST BOSTON DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON. *Chap. 29*

*Resolved,* That the division of metropolitan planning of the metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized and directed to investigate and study the subject matter of current house documents numbered one hundred and forty-one and sixteen hundred and sixteen, relative to the extension of rapid transit facilities in the East Boston district of the city of Boston. Said division shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of December in the current year.
