

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO ADJUSTMENTS OF GRIEVANCES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND TO THE MAINTENANCE OF EMPLOYEES IN THE SEVERAL INSTITUTIONS OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND THE LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLICABLE THERETO. Chap. 73

*Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of one member of the senate to be designated by the president thereof, three members of the house of representatives to be designated by the speaker thereof, and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and study concerning the present methods by which grievances of employees of the commonwealth may be presented and adjusted, and the adequacy of present methods, including the subject matter of current senate document numbered thirty-one; and also concerning the laws and rules and regulations applicable to the maintenance of employees of the several institutions of the commonwealth, including requirements as to living in, the treatment of maintenance in determination of salary, both of those who live in and those who live out, the accommodations provided or available at the several institutions for employees who live in and the adequacy of these accommodations for housing those employees who in the interest of safety and efficiency or by reason of inadequacy of accommodations on private property in the vicinity should reside on the premises, including the subject matter of current senate document numbered two hundred and ninety-nine. The commission shall also consider the subject matter of current house document numbered seventeen hundred and seventy-seven, being a resolve providing for an investigation and study by a special commission relative to adjustments of grievances of employees of the commonwealth and the laws, rules and regulations applicable thereto. The commission shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, and may expend with the approval of the governor and council for clerical and other services and expenses such sums not exceeding in the aggregate five thousand dollars as may hereafter be appropriated therefor. Said special commission shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation or rules or regulations necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of November in the year nineteen hundred and forty-four. *Approved June 12, 1943.*
