PRESS INFORMATION ON GOVERNOR'S STATEWIDE ADDRESS TONIGHT

The Governor will appear on statewide radio and television at 7:30 tonight to outline the administration's fiscal 1976 budget recommendations and the magnitude of the anticipated deficit.

ADVANCE TEXT AND BACK-UP MATERIALS

An advance text of the address and detailed back-up materials will be distributed in the State House press rooms at approximately 4:45 p.m. Monday -- on a strict 7:30 p.m. embargo basis. Back-up materials will include the following:

1. Comparative summary of appropriations for FY74-76 by secretariat, constitutional office, etc.
2. Comparative summary of appropriations for FY74-76 by fund.
3. Comparative surplus/deficit statements for FY74-76 by fund.
4. Comparison of FY75-76 authorized positions by secretariat, showing number of positions deleted from FY76 budget and number of positions added.
5. Statement of number of layoffs by secretariat.
6. Comparison of FY75 and FY76 controllable and uncontrollable expenditures by secretariat.
7. Estimate of what the FY76 budget would have been without cuts.
