RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF ALFRED R. WOOD OF BOSTON.

Chap. 27

Resolved, That, for the purpose of discharging a moral obligation of the commonwealth and subject to appropriation, there shall be allowed and paid out of the state treasury to Alfred R. Wood, of Boston, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars in part payment of his claim against the commonwealth for injuries sustained in the line of duty while attending the Massachusetts National Guard encampment at Camp Plattsburg, Plattsburg, New York, in the year nineteen hundred and forty. No payment shall be made hereunder until there has been filed with the comptroller an agreement signed by said Alfred R. Wood that the amount, if any, paid or to be paid for legal services rendered in connection with the passage of this resolve shall not exceed ten per cent of the amount paid or payable hereunder.

RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF BASIL H. COONEY OF LAWRENCE.

Chap. 28

Resolved, That, for the purpose of discharging a moral obligation of the commonwealth, there be allowed and paid out of the state treasury to Basil H. Cooney of Lawrence, such sums as may be appropriated therefor, because of loss of salary, medical and hospital expenses and other expenses incurred as a result of injuries sustained by him on June twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and forty-seven, while engaged in training at the state police training school at Framingham.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE PARTICIPATION BY THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE OBSERVANCE OF THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE SPANISH-AMERICAN WAR, THE PHILIPPINE INSURRECTION AND THE CHINA RELIEF EXPEDITION.

Chap. 29

Resolved, That, in order that the commonwealth may participate in the observance in the current year of the fiftieth anniversary of the Spanish-American War, the Philippine Insurrection and the China Relief Expedition, and to ensure, in arranging events in connection therewith, proper co-operation between the Massachusetts Department of the United Spanish War Veterans and the commonwealth, and to contribute toward the transportation and other expenses of veterans participating in the observance of said anniversary, there may be expended, with the approval and under the direction of the governor and council, such sums as may hereafter be appropriated therefor.
