

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A PROPER REPRESENTATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH AT THE NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE ARMY AND NAVY UNION, U. S. A., TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER IN THE CURRENT YEAR. *Chap. 19*

*Resolved,* That, in order that the commonwealth may be properly represented on the occasion of the national convention of the Army and Navy Union, U. S. A., to be held in the city of Worcester in August of the current year, and to ensure, in arranging entertainments and other events in connection therewith, proper co-operation between Army and Navy Union, U. S. A., Department of Massachusetts, Inc. and the commonwealth, after an appropriation has been made therefor, there may be expended, with the approval and under the direction of the governor and council, such sum, not exceeding three thousand dollars, as may be appropriated therefor.

RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF EDWIN J. CONNORS, ALICE M. CONNORS AND LENA L. CONNORS OF SPRINGFIELD. *Chap. 20*

*Resolved,* That, for the purpose of discharging a moral obligation of the commonwealth and after an appropriation has been made therefor, there shall be allowed and paid from the state treasury to Edwin J. Connors and Alice M. Connors, both of Springfield, who were injured, and to Lena L. Connors of Springfield, whose property was damaged, on August second, nineteen hundred and fifty, by reason of being struck by a wild deer which was struck by another motor vehicle and hurled against the motor vehicle in which they were riding on the highway between Brewster and Provincetown, such sum, not exceeding one thousand dollars, as may be appropriated therefor. No payment shall be made hereunder until there has been filed with the comptroller an agreement, signed by each of said persons, that the amount, if any, paid or to be paid for legal services rendered in connection with the passage of this resolve shall not exceed ten per cent of the sum paid hereunder.
