

RESOLVE EXTENDING THE TIME FOR FILING FINAL REPORTS OF CERTAIN INVESTIGATIONS AND STUDIES BY THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COUNCIL. *Chap.134*

*Resolved,* That the time for the legislative research council to submit its final reports under chapters eighty-six and one hundred and nine of the resolves of the current year, respectively, is hereby extended to the fourth Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF CERTAIN MATTERS RELATING TO THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW. *Chap.135*

*Resolved,* That an unpaid special commission, to consist of three members of the senate to be designated by the president thereof, seven members of the house of representatives to be designated by the speaker thereof, and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of current senate documents numbered 249 and 259; and of current house documents numbered 829, 830, 954, 1352, and 1579.

Said commission shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, administer oaths, require by summons the attendance and testimony of witnesses and the production of books and papers, may travel within and without the commonwealth, and may expend therefor and for legal, technical, clerical and other services and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

Said commission shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives at such time or times as it may deem desirable, and in any event, shall file a final report not later than the last Monday of December in the current year.

RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE ACTIVITIES OF ACCIDENT AND HEALTH INSURANCE COMPANIES, THE ISSUANCE OF CREDIT LIFE, HEALTH AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE TO CREDITORS IN CONNECTION WITH FINANCE CONTRACTS, AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS. *Chap.136*

*Resolved,* That the unpaid special commission established by chapter one hundred and three of the resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty-six shall, in making its investigation and
