

**Chap. 125.** RESOLVE FURTHER EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE A STUDY RELATIVE TO THE ORGANIZATION AND OPERATION OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION AND OTHER MATTERS IS REQUIRED TO FILE ITS FINAL REPORT.

*Resolved,* That the time within which the unpaid special commission established by chapter one hundred and forty of the resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty-eight and revived and continued by chapter six of the resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty-nine is required to file its final report is hereby further extended to the last Wednesday of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-one. Said commission may expend for expert, legal, clerical and other services and expenses the unexpended balance in item 0259-01 of section two of chapter one hundred and seventy-one of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.

**Chap. 126.** RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE LOCATION OF A NEW SITE FOR THE MASSACHUSETTS COLLEGE OF ART AND THE ERECTION THEREON OF CERTAIN BUILDINGS OF SAID COLLEGE.

*Resolved,* That an unpaid special commission consisting of two members of the senate, to be designated by the president thereof, three members of the house of representatives, to be designated by the speaker thereof, the commissioner of education, the director of the division of building construction, and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established to make a survey of state owned land with a view to locating and erecting thereon the Massachusetts College of Art. Said commission shall in the course of its investigation and study consider the subject matter of current house document numbered 3381, authorizing the board of education to sell the land and buildings presently occupied by the Massachusetts College of Art and providing for the acquisition of land for the construction of new buildings for said college and the preparation of plans for said construction. Said commission shall consider the advisability of erecting at such appropriate site the construction of new buildings for said College, and furnish estimates of the cost of constructing said buildings. Said commission shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within the commonwealth and may expend for clerical and other assistance and for expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said commission shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or before the last Friday of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-one.
