Monitoring Policy

The Board reviewed a draft acknowledgement form for proposed practice monitors to sign that Mr. Kelley prepared. After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Jones, seconded by Dr. Glover, to approve the acknowledgment form. The motion passed unanimously.

- **Karen Marans, 2017-000884-IT-ENF, 2nd and Final Quarterly Monitoring Report:** After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Anderson, seconded by Dr. Marshall, to accept the report. The motion passed unanimously.
- **Tammy Bean, 20150804PY001-IT-ENF, 6th Quarterly Monitoring Report:** After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Glover, seconded by Dr. Jones, to accept the report. The motion passed unanimously.
- **Ricky Greenwald, 2017-000912-IT-ENF, Appeal of the Rejection of Supervisory Reports:** The Board reviewed two letters submitted by Dr. Greenwald in response to the Board's rejection of his supervisor's last two quarterly reports and his supervisor's latest report, which because of the Board's rejection of the last two reports is the second quarterly report. After discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Anderson, seconded by Dr. Marshall, to direct board staff to send a letter to Dr. Greenwald and his supervisor, Dr. Margaret Miller, that includes the following information:

- The latest report from Dr. Miller did not indicate that she discussed either the underlying case with Dr. Greenwald or the harm caused to the child and the child's relationship with the biological mother as required by the Board.
- A copy of the underlying Vermont Supreme Court decision for Dr. Greenwald's case.
- Dr. Greenwald is permitted to supervise an LICSW, LMHC, or licensed psychologist to fulfill the Board's requirement that Dr. Greenwald supervise clinical cases.
- The Board is holding Dr. Miller's latest report until she supplements that report as described above. She must supplement the report before the Board's meeting on April 17, 2020.

The motion passed unanimously.

Application Review

The Board discussed Dr. Patrick's educational and experience credentials, specifically his doctorate from a program in Canada that was not CPA-approved. After discussion, the Board, by unanimous consent, directed staff to ask Dr. Patrick for an international credentials evaluation from an APA-approved evaluator.
