



## Shared Streets and Spaces Program Total Funding Doubles to \$10 Million

On Thursday, September 10, Massachusetts Governor Charlie Baker, Lieutenant Governor Karyn Polito and Secretary of Transportation Stephanie Pollack announced the total amount available to municipalities in the Baker-Polito Administration's Shared Streets and Spaces Emergency Grant Program was increasing, from an initial program total of \$5 million to \$10 million. City and town leaders have through September 22 to apply for funding. The Shared Streets and Spaces program provides grants as small as \$5,000 and as large as \$300,000 for cities and towns to quickly implement or expand improvements to sidewalks, curbs, streets, on-street parking spaces and off-street parking lots in support of public health, safe mobility, and renewed commerce in their communities.
