



MassDOT announces \$868,301.35 in Shared Streets & Spaces Program awards

MassDOT this week announced the award of more than \$800,000 in the latest rounds of funding from the Baker-Polito Administration's Shared Streets & Spaces program. The program, which was launched on June 10, provides technical and funding assistance to help Massachusetts cities and towns conceive, design, and implement tactical changes to curbs, streets, on-street parking spaces, and off-street parking lots in support of public health, safe mobility, and renewed commerce. With the award of these new rounds of funding, the program will have given out a total of \$8.5 million to fund 99 projects in 85 municipalities across the Commonwealth, of which 60% are Environmental Justice communities.
