



### Massachusetts Department of Correction Covid-19 Daily Inmate Testing Report

Through its medical vendor Wellpath, The Massachusetts Department of Correction (DOC) provides COVID-19 testing to symptomatic inmates/patients and close contacts when clinically indicated. Additionally, large scale and targeted testing is periodically conducted for asymptomatic inmates/patients through mobile testing. Inmate testing is voluntary, yet strongly encouraged.

The dashboard is based on a culmination of data collected by Wellpath for all testing types and is based on the test result date. As some inmates may have tested multiple times, this reporting is inclusive of all tests including duplicates. The dashboard displays the inmate/patient COVID-19 daily test counts [1] based on the test result date and displays counts by test results, deaths [2], demographics, DOC institutions, respective county and city/town which are based where the inmate was housed when tested.

[1] Test results do not appear each day; only dates with test results appear in the date dropdown selector. Inmate test counts of one (1) to four (4) are reported as 1-4; five (5) and over are reported as the actual count.

[2] Deceased counts are based on the inmate's date of death
