

SECTION 3. When trial justices discharge without complaint persons arrested for drunkenness, they shall be entitled to the same compensation as in cases where there are trials.

In case of discharge without complaint.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT RELATING TO CHANGES IN THE NAME OF CERTAIN CORPORATIONS.

*Chap.201*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter three hundred and sixty of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one shall not apply to any corporation organized or transacting business under the provisions of chapter four hundred and twenty-nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, or acts amendatory thereof.

Provisions of 1891, 360, not to apply, etc.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF HOLDING PROBATE COURTS IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK.

*Chap.202*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. After the first day of June next the sessions of the probate court for the county of Suffolk shall be held at Boston on every Thursday in each year, except the first, second, fourth and fifth Thursdays of August, instead of at the times now provided by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO EXEMPT FROM TAXATION CERTAIN REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE ODD FELLOWS' HOME OF MASSACHUSETTS.

*Chap.203*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The real estate of the odd fellows' home of Massachusetts situated in the city of Worcester, and the personal property belonging to said home or held by the trustees thereof for the purpose of said home, to the amount provided in chapter one hundred and fifteen of the Public Statutes, shall be exempt from taxation so long as said real and personal property shall be used for the purpose of said home, in accordance with the rules and regu-

Property exempt from taxation.
